

prior written notice to students and parents/guardians about the District's surveillance system, including the sites where surveillance may occur, explaining that the recordings may be used in disciplinary proceedings, and that matters captured by the camera may be referred to local law enforcement, as appropriate under Board policy or law.

Students and staff shall not tamper or interfere with video camera equipment.

individuals.

7. School Resource Officers assigned to a particular school or district, may view video images when there is a reasonable suspicion that the image depicts an event or action related to a crime or violation of school rules, or the image depicts a situation constituting a health or safety emergency requiring immediate action to protect the pupil or other individuals.

These images of an individual's pupil, shall not be considered by the District as a student record and may be released to law enforcement for any reason. To the extent that any images from the District's surveillance system create a student or personnel record, the Superintendent or designee shall ensure that the images are

Superintendent, or designee(s), and public safety personnel.

This Policy does not apply to surveillance cameras placed by any law enforcement

police; or any state or federal law enforcement agency. These agencies are governed by laws and regulations pertaining to the activities of the agency.
